### ***FEANI hosts the Kick Off Meeting of the “Engineers for Europe” project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme***

On September 22 and 23, FEANI hosted in Brussels the two-day meeting to launch the international project “Engineers for Europe” (E4E), co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union.

FEANI is the lead partner and coordinator of Engineers for Europe, an Alliance for Innovation that brings together excellence in the engineering profession: 13 partners from eight European countries representing academia, research, industry and the engineering profession. The E4E project has three main pillars of institution building, strategic foresight and training to sustain the competitiveness of the engineering profession.

In the next three years, FEANI will oversee the implementation of the project to establish the European Engineering Skills Council, identify future trends and needs in skills and competences for engineers and develop innovative training on transversal skills for the profession.

FEANI will play a crucial role in defining the structure and governance of the Skills Council, anticipating skills mismatches for the engineering profession and drafting the Skills Strategy for the European engineering profession
